

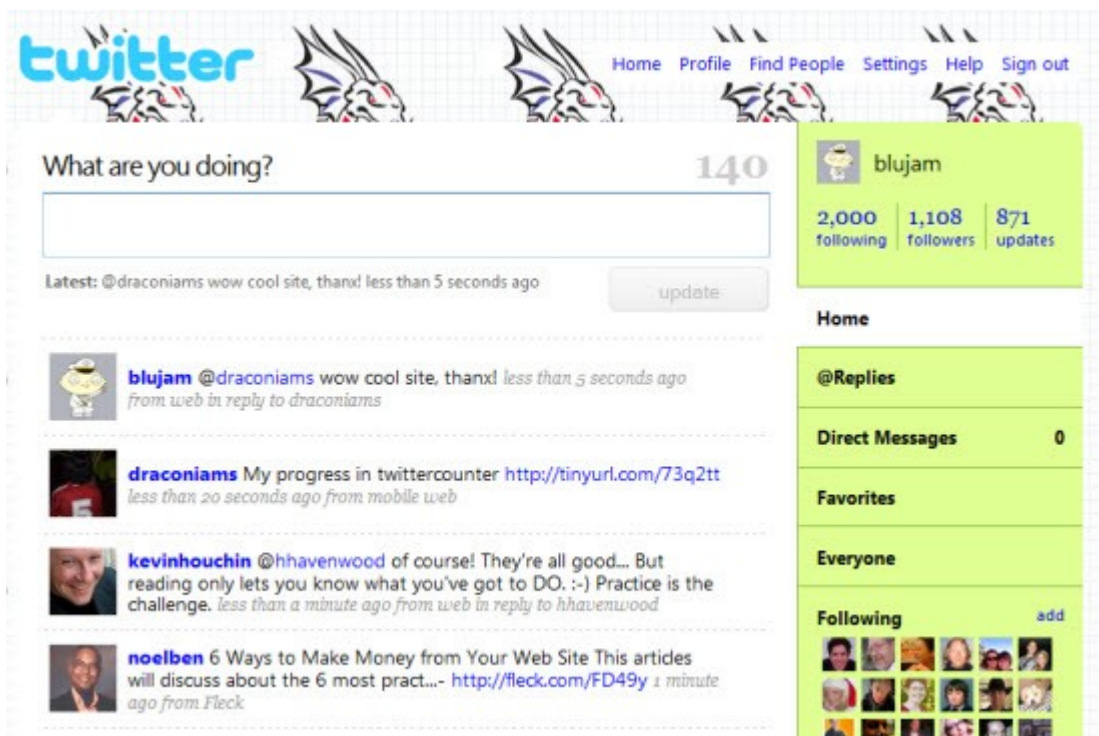


Hi Friend,

I'm Jeff Davis and this is my story...

I wanted a bigger list, and I discovered twitter, which is a micro-blog website.



As you can see it's pretty simple, you can just post, but you are limited to 140 characters.

Or you can do a reply, which is in the @blujam format...if you float your mouse to the right you will see a little arrow, and when you click on that, you'll be replying to the other twitterer...

Twitter has a lot of jargon, for instance people are tweeples...and the twitter community is known as the twitterverse...



There are so many applications that apply to twitter, there is no way I could go through all of them in a short report...

So, I'm just going to show you what I did, and what happened.

At first, I just let it grow organically, and I got up to about 250 followers, just posting, and using twitter as a fairly ignorant user...

Then one day I saw a video on youtube, that showed me a neat little trick to build your followers up...

You have to give to get, simple as that...

You follow others, and they will follow you back!

But here's what I was missing....

I didn't know that if you click on someone's followers twitter shows you the list of their followers, and they give you a little follow button.



So, I clicked the link, and low and behold, there was the list of all the followers... then it was just a matter of following all the people you can possibly follow, which is capped at 2000.

But, you CAN follow 2000 people!

And here's what works in your favor, some, but not all, are programmed to automatically follow you back...so you automatically gain followers...



Then I followed the maximum amount of people, but, here's the deal...there's a lot of robots, and autoposters, so I ONLY followed people with a picture, that had normal names. If I detected annoying robot posts I simply unfollow that user.

Twittelligence

The thing to remember about using twitter to build your list is that you have to use your head, and respond to tweeple, and help them solve their problems, and be a good guy/gal, and not be that person who is just blasting ads, constantly...after all it IS a community, and a social gathering spot...

The twitterverse is not stupid, and tweeple can spot that behavior a mile away...so get to know some folks, and twitter responsibly...

The cool thing is, that tweeple are really smart and cool, and they will be attracted to you, if you are nice, and are of service, and you add value to their twitter experience.



Twitbuilder

Here's what happened...

1. I followed 2,000 people
2. I got roughly 50% response
3. I built my list to over 1,000 in a week.



I had a lot of fun, and I joined blip.fm and I share music on twitter...that's just me, I like to share music, because I'm a musician, and music is a powerful force with tweeple.

A few people use blip.fm to share music, it's neat to see what people are listening to...I think it lets you get inside their experience, and feel what they are feeling...



Here's a cool website that expands your blogging capabilities, it's called [twitwall](#).

This is how I embed videos in posts for my tweeple to consume...my personal rule is I only advertise products about 1 in 7 posts...



Another little site I joined is [friendfeed](#) which helps me broadcast.

Additional tactics I employ are...

1. I use [aweber](#) to broadcast to twitter..
2. I use [tweetmyblog plugin](#) to broadcast my blog posts to twitter..
3. I use [podomatic](#) to broadcast my podcasts to twitter...
4. I use [twitpic](#) to share pictures on twitter...



On my twitwall there's a link to another site called [twitter grader](#) and as you can see, with a little time you can get a really good rating...trust me I didn't put much effort into this, I'm pretty lazy!
